



## Online Privacy Policy

Community National Bank & Trust has a long-standing commitment to protecting the confidentiality of our customer's personal financial information. You can read about that commitment in detail in the Privacy section of this site. However, because of the unique nature of the Internet, we believe it will be helpful to have an overview of how this commitment is applied when Community National Bank & Trust collects, uses and protects your personal information when you visit us online.

### **The types of information we collect and how it is used**

When you visit the Community National Bank & Trust web site we may collect navigational information such as pages visited and average time spent on a particular page. This is done to help us analyze our site design and enhance your user experience. We may also collect technical information concerning your computer browser type, IP address, or the presence of any software necessary to view our site.

We also collect personal information provided by you or your representative on applications, forms, and e-mails. We use this information for many purposes including processing transactions in your account, responding to product applications and questions, and to fulfill regulatory requirements. The information we collect is used to deliver the services you have requested. Community National Bank & Trust maintains strict policies to protect against the unauthorized disclosure or use of customer information and maintains extensive safeguards to prevent unauthorized access.

Community National Bank & Trust will NEVER email customers and ask for information. If an email is received asking for information such as account numbers, tax id numbers, PIN numbers, etc. please contact Community National Bank & Trust at (620) 431-2265 immediately.

### **Security**

One of the most important priorities in providing you with online banking services is the security of your personal financial information. When you send personal information to us over the Internet, our security standards guard it in several ways. We use secure transmissions to encrypt information which helps protect it from interception by a third party. The use of firewalls, pass codes and other safety features we've installed also help ensure that the information you provide us remains safe and secure.
